

## Camping Checklist

Mandatory:

Class A Scout Uniform (depending on campout will be required for certain activities)
Class B Scout Uniform

The following list is by no means mandatory, only suggestions for being "always prepared"

tent with waterproof ground cloth or plastic sheet mallet for driving tent stakes sleeping bag and pillow camp chair (folding light weight chair)

water, water (you can never get enough)
canteen or re-usable water bottle (marked with your name)
insect repellent
sun screen

sturdy walking shoes (close toed) – open toed shoes & sandles are not allowed at camp extra tennis shoes or comfortable shoes (close toed)

sleeping clothes (pajamas or similar)

changes of clothing and extra socks

grooming needs (soap, washcloth, toothpaste, toothbrush etc.)

shower shoes

towel

headgear (hat) for sun protection

poncho or raincoat

sweater or jacket – bring clothing appropriate to expected weather – it gets cold at night

flashlight (don't forget extra batteries)

whistle

pen/pencil

compass

Bible

scout handbook (some activities may be completed)

trading post money (sometimes there is a store, sometimes not, \$10-\$20 suggested)

pocket knife, pocket tool (proper documentation for use)

fire tools (proper documentation for use)

hair tie if you have long hair and are working fire

your neckerchief works as a hair tie - test it to make sure you know how
